Youth Easter Egg Hunt



The KPRD will host a Youth Easter Egg Hunt on Saturday, March 31. The hunt will be held at Northwest Park and begin at 1pm. This program is for children age 10 and under only. Groups will be divided by ages 0-3 yrs, 4-6 yrs and 7-10 yrs and will utilize the softball diamonds. **BRING YOUR OWN BASKET!!!** This program is FREE and open to the public. No registration is required. All children must be accompanied by an adult.

Adult Easter Egg Hunt

The KPRD will host an Adult Easter Egg Hunt on Saturday, March 31. The hunt will be held at Jackson Morrow Park and begin at 8:30pm. This event is for adults only 18 and over. Wristbands are required to enter the "hunt zone" and may be purchased for \$5 each (CASH ONLY) at the Park office beginning March 5. They will also be available at Jackson Morrow Park the day of the hunt from 5pm until the hunt begins. The hunt is held in the dark so you may want to bring a flashlight. Bring your own bag. Call the Parks & Recreation office with any questions.



Community Garage Sales

The KPRD offers two community garage sales on the parking lot at Kokomo Beach. Both sales are held rain or shine. The Spring sale will be held on Friday, May 4 and the Fall sale will be held on Friday, September 21. The sales are from 9am-2pm with set-up beginning at 6:30am. To participate, parking spaces may be purchased for \$5 each and you may purchase as many as you need. All spaces must be purchased at the Parks & Recreation office in Highland Park and need to be reserved in advance. You must be 18 or older to reserve a space and there are some limitations on merchandise that can be sold. Contact the Parks & Recreation office for further details.



Pumpkin Painting

The Kirkendall Nature Center will offer pumpkin painting on Saturday, October 20 from 11-4pm. This event is FREE and open to the public. Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult. Pumpkins are free while supplies last but it is recommended that you bring your own.

Kirkendall Interpretive Nature Center

The Retha Kirkendall Interpretive Nature Center is a Community Educational Facility designed for use in the education of Indiana's Natural Resources and Wildlife of the State of Indiana.
